Information Packet

There are currently 15 spots reserved. 11 spots are available for the kids, 4 spots are for sponsors/chaperones (2 male/2 female). If we have more sign up, we will put them on a waiting list. Once we know from the camp we have space to add them, we will add them to our group.

The **cost of camp (per student/chaperone) is \$99.00.**

IF you will not be able to make the full payment, or cost is an issue for your family, please **DO NOT LET THIS KEEP YOUR STUDENT FROM COMING!** We have a limited amount of scholarship money available, AND we also have **many** individuals who are just waiting for the opportunity to help financially. Please let Brad know ASAP about it! We want all our of group to go! (We also want your lost friend to join us too!)

Who Is Eligible to Go?

- Anyone who is in 6th - 12th grade is eligible to attend! *Go Tell requires that you/ your student must be in or just completed the grade: 6th - 12th grade.*
- If you/your student does not attend Unity, or is not a member of Unity, you/they are still eligible and encouraged to attend camp with us. We do ask that they make **every effort** to be a part of our student ministry as opportunity allows!

How Much Money Should my Child Bring?

As always, Go Tell will have a camp store selling CD's, T-shirts, hats, etc. Items at the camp store run in the area from \$5-\$30+. Your student will also be responsible for a meal on the way and a meal coming home. We suggest \$50-\$70. *The amount of spending money is ultimately up to you and your teen.*



CAMPER INFORMATION

What to Wear:

- Casual clothes for the day: modest shorts/t-shirts.
- Swimming:
 - Guys – MODEST swimsuits no higher than mid-thigh.
T-shirts must be worn in all indoor locations and to & from swimming area.
 - Girls – MODEST one-piece swimsuits or modest Tankinis (must cover your stomach). A large dark T-shirt or cover-up must be worn to and from the swimming area.

COLOR WAR: One afternoon we will have an event called the Color War. Students will throw various colors of chalk at one another. Please bring shirt/shorts that you don't mind getting messed up – as the chalk may stain.

What NOT to Wear:

- Shorts, tops, skirts, etc., that are too tight.
- Short shorts (hem no shorter than fingertips when arm is extended).
- Skimpy Tops (Halter, etc.) or shirts that don't meet your pants or rise up above your pants when arms are raised.
- T-shirts with distasteful designs or messages.
- Bikinis, Tankinis, French-cut, or one-piece resembling two-piece swimsuits.
- Spaghetti-strap tops (unless you have a shirt underneath).
- Pants that are too low cut and don't allow you to bend over without being embarrassed!



CAMPER INFORMATION

What to Pack:

- Bible, notebook, pen
- Toiletry items
- Bath towels (We recommend that students bring unique patterns and colors to keep things separate in their rooms)
- Linens: Twin Sheets, Pillow and blanket. Camper's housing accommodations are dorm rooms.
- Limited spending money - Vending machines and snack shops are available.

What NOT to Pack:

1. Any item that is illegal, dangerous, or may be used to cause damage to the camp facility or harm an individual (examples: alcoholic beverages, drugs, fireworks, weapons, water balloons, or water guns, etc.).
2. Tobacco products – GO TELL Camp has a no-tobacco policy.
3. If used inappropriately - Media/Music/Video devices (including cell phones) may be confiscated.

GO TELL Camps reserve the right to collect any item that violates the above provisions.

First Aid/Medication

Medical personnel will be on duty throughout the week of camp. All serious cases of sickness or injury should be reported to the medical staff immediately.

Nurses station will be open the following hours:

Monday: 1:00-9:00PM Tuesday-Thursday: 9:00AM-9:00PM

Infirmary will have basic first aid items available.

Valuables

GO TELL Ministries and each GO TELL Camp venue cannot accept responsibility for missing items. Therefore, it is advised that campers not bring unnecessary valuables to camp. Each camper is responsible for his/her own cash and valuable items.





EMERGENCIES

Incase of emergency, parents will be notified as soon as possible. It is important that you have Brad's cell number saved (**606-571-6192**). He will be the liaison for emergency situations.

Medical Release Forms

Make sure you have filled out Go Tell's medical release form, and Unity Baptist Church's medical release form. This information will allow quicker service within the emergency department, should any case arise. **The Go Tell Medical Release form will be emailed to you.** It will come from Brad. Once you fill it out, please print, or email a PDF copy to Brad : ubcyouth.ashland@gmail.com. If you have no means to do this online, **there will be a paper copy available upon request.** Brad will then enter it online for you.

Incase of an emergency, on the home side, and your student needs to be informed, picked up, etc., contact Brad. He will make arrangements as needed.

Medical/Medicine Information:

If your student has to take any medication, we ask that you provide a detailed list of medicines, dosages, and times they need to take it. We will make sure they are taken within the recommendations from the Dr.

If there are any specialized medicines that need to be stored in a refrigerator, or locked up for safety reasons, please specify this. There is a place for you to provide this information in the online registration.

We want to ensure the safety of all our students and those around them, and we appreciate your partnership in this!


