Our highly trained FUGE Camps staffers will take care of the details, lead Bible study and facilitate the planning for each day. At MFuge, Students are divided into groups for Bible study and ministry based on the type of work they request. Adult leaders from your church accompany Bible study groups to the ministry site. Lunch is provided on campus before groups leave for site.

During the day your students will be challenged and stretched as individuals; in the evenings, you'll have an opportunity to build group unity over dinner, worship, fellowship and church group devotions.

MFuge is designed to give students a mission experience that opens their eyes to similar opportunities they may have to serve in their own communities, learning to live life each day on mission!

MINISTRY TRACKS

M-FUGE is a camp that focuses on serving. Each student will be placed in a group with other students who have signed up for similar track interest. Here is a list of the current tracks available:

Childrens, Games and Rec, PCY (Painting, Construction, and Yardwork), Social. *Track times offered are subject to change and depend on the size of camp for the session attending.

In the registration, you will have to option to pick which track you will want to serve in. FUGE usually asks you to pick three that interest you. This is all based on number of students that attend camp and ministry sites they are able to use.

The ministry sites are all over the Ridgecrest area. Many will be in the Asheville area as well.

THE NITTY GRIDDY

Dates: June 15-19 (Saturday - Wednesday)

We will meet at the church back parking lot at 6:30am. Travelers are allowed to have two bags and a carry-on. From here, we will load the trailer and transportation vehicles and head to Ridgecrest. This will allow us plenty of time for travel and check-in.

As of now, on Wednesday, camp is set to let out at 10:45am. Once we are on the road for home, our team will send out notification via Remind, Unity studentz FB page, and Realm Connect. We estimate a return to the church around 6pm. Be watching for *updated* ETA's!

Cost: \$384 per person

Chaperones and students attending are responsible for their cost of camp. It is our desire to see ALL of our students attend camp with us. God uses this week in a massive way to help turn our students hearts, minds, and souls, to Him! IF the cost of camp is the factor of letting your student go, please speak with Brad. We have scholarships available for those who need some financial assistance. There is a scholarship link in the registration for you to fill out.

Every student that registers is responsible to pay the non refundable \$75 registration fee. Those who have applied for scholarship, this fee is not included in the scholarship. You will still need to cover the registration fee. This payment is due within 5 days of registering. You can do this online, or via cash or check.

We have been approved to give those who have three or more students going a little bit of a discount. Families that have three students attending: 10% / Families that have 4 or more attending: 20%. Again, if you need financial assistance, hit the scholarship link up! We will get you to camp!

Spending Money

Food: Students and Chaperones will be responsible for 2 meals (Lunch Saturday, Lunch Wenesday) and any snacks they will want to get on campus. Ridgecrest does have a snack shack, and a good coffee place on campus. Those are usually open during free time.
